VISION

MISSION

We seek to bridge the skills gap between the sought-after skilled labor force and youth full of potential. We aim to achieve this by giving young talents access to high-quality training in the field of IT to equip them with the necessary skills and knowledge to succeed in the dynamic digital age. Thereby we provide them the opportunity to improve their life quality by enabling access to a dignifying living wage and sustainable employment.



SELECTION OF TALENTS

Highly motivated young women who are enthusiastic about technology and come from economically disadvantaged backgrounds.





RESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP ALLOCATION

The selected talents will receive a full scholarship to conduct the boot camp for one year on our residential campus in Makerere, Uganda.

12 MONTHS TRAINING PERIOD

A full-time training program in Software Engineering will be deployed with the support of our educational partner. Refactory. A compulsory internship will complement the training program to continue the talent's practical preparation and experience development.





MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

The remote mentorship program with mentors from our partner companies is spanning the full duration of the program. It gives the Talents valuable support and insights, and the mentors a great way of employee engagement.



Out of the curriculum, support includes modules on the development of 'soft skills' necessary for their professional development, along with professional counseling and efforts to build young talents' confidence in their own potential.





JOB PLACEMENT SUPPORT

The program focuses on providing a smooth transition into employment within Ugandan companies as an initial career step. The graduates gain valuable experience and skills, laying the groundwork for potential future opportunities within internationally operating organizations.



MENTOR REQUIREMENTS



The mentorship program is structured as a long-term scheme, starting April 2024 until January 2025.

It includes mentorship sessions, training, consulting, and guidance for our young talents in Uganda. It will be fully remote.

- Knowledge of programming languages and experience in the tech sphere
- Expertise in both technical and soft skills
- Around 4 mentoring hours per month/ 1 hour per week (time can be arranged individually with the mentee)

- Give feedback so we can continue to develop and refine the program
